

Garden Manager Volunteer Position



Our Massabesic Center Community Garden is heading into its 3rd season. We are looking for an enthusiastic gardener(s) who would like to manage our garden. Come enjoy working on a garden while helping other enthusiastic gardeners

Purpose:

The Garden Manager (or co-managers) is the liaison between the Community Garden and the Massabesic Center staff. They will be in charge of relaying garden policies, encouraging a sense of community in the garden, facilitating communication among the garden group, and helping gardeners with organic gardening techniques.

Qualifications:

Knowledge of vegetables, fruits, and flowers, experience in organic gardening and pest control, working with a variety of personalities, enthusiastic, flexible. The Garden Manager(s) will be in charge of assigning plots to participants, and answering any questions participants may have. The garden manger(s) will have support from the Center Director and Volunteer Coordinator.

Time Commitment:

May through October. Approximately 4-8 hours a month depending on the time of season. This can be split between co-managers

Responsibilities

- Assign garden plots and report unused plots to Center Director
- Gather contact information, and provide communication to gardeners of policy updates, activities, or other relevant information
- Organize garden work days and encourage gardeners to work together
- Help in the distribution of extra crops to the Massabesic Center's Animal Ambassadors (frogs, turtles, etc) or to a community food bank.
- Notify Massabesic center staff of maintenance needs or issues that need attending to
